ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES & POSTER AWARDS

Abstract Format

- Language: English
- Title: max. 25 words
- Length: max. 300 words; 1 Figure (4 x 16 cm) counts for 90 words
- Structure: Background, Methods, Results, Conclusions

Deadline of Submission

- Deadline Abstract Submission: **Tuesday, July 9, 2019**

Additional Information

- The data must not have been published (unless in abstract form).
- The presented data can originate from the field of basic-, clinical science or pilot studies in respiratory medicine. Excluded are all clinical phase III- or IV-studies initiated or sponsored by industry.
- Clinical studies must have been approved by the ethics committee.
- Animal experiments require an animal welfare officer's approval.
- The study must have been performed predominantly in Europe.
- At submission of the abstract the author agrees to publication in *The Central European Journal of Medicine (Wiener Klinische Wochenschrift)*.

Reviewing

- Ten national and international renowned scientists from different fields in clinical and basic science will be invited to review the abstracts on an anonymous basis.
- Grading system: A maximum of ten points will be assigned per abstract. Reviewers will not be allowed to evaluate abstracts in case of conflict of interest (e.g. from their own study group).
- **The 6 abstracts with the highest average score** (3 for Poster Award for Basic Research and 3 for Poster Award for Clinical Research) **will be invited to give an oral presentation** at the ASP Meeting. The presentation and following discussion will be given in English.

Format of Presentation

Poster Presentation

All abstracts will be presented in the Poster Exhibition. During the Poster Walk, each Poster will be presented for 2-3 minutes.

Oral Presentation

- The 6 abstracts with the highest average score will be invited to give an oral presentation.
- Language: English
- 10 minutes presentation, 4 minutes discussion (after the presentation)
- Oral Poster Jury: A maximum of 10 points for the oral presentation including discussion will be assigned by the reviewers.
- The average of both scores (abstract & oral presentation) will serve to set the final ranking.

Poster Awards

- Everyone below the age of 35 submitting an abstract is eligible to apply for the ASP poster awards.
- First authors of multiple abstracts must choose one abstract to enter the contest.
At submission authors must declare which of the poster award they apply for. (Scientific Poster Award for Basic Research or Scientific Poster Award for Clinical Research).
